Performance Notes

Percussion or handclaps may be added, as indicated by X's, both during the antiphon and at the end of the psalm verses to lead back into the antiphon.

The antiphon should be repeated every time it is sung.

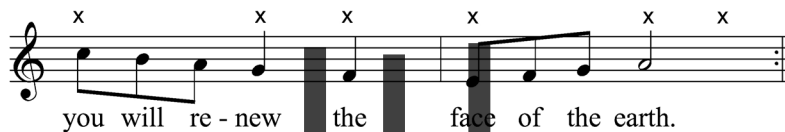
The entire piece may be transposed down a whole step.
