

9. In the LORD, hold firm	and take heart.	Hope in the LORD!

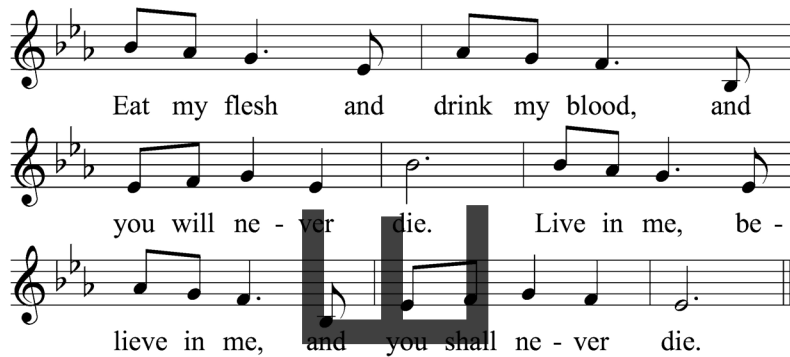
